

Dashboard Center Panel Removal/Installation

NOTE:


- Put on gloves to protect your hands.
- Do not pry the panel surface with a flat-tip screwdriver, to prevent damage.
- Take care not to scratch the dashboard and related parts.
- 1. Remove these items:
 - Inner glove box
 - Passenger's dashboard under cover
- 2. Remove the screw (A). Detach the clips (B) and release the hooks (C) by pulling the center lower cover (D) down, by hand.



RHD:



- 3. Disconnect the heater control unit connectors (D), and release the unit harness (E) from the clamp.
- 4. In the inner glove box opening, disconnect the recirculation control cable and the mode control cable (B), and from under the dashboard, disconnect the air mix control cable (C):
 - Take care not to bend any cables.
 - LHD is shown, RHD is symmetrical.



5. From the glove box and driver's dashboard lower cover openings, loosen the bolts securing the center panel (A).
