

Malladus 2.0 for LG G2 VS980

This process works coming from 10B, 11A, 12B, 17F, or 24A.

Disclaimer: I'm not held responsible for any issues that may arise with your phone by taking the below steps. While several testers have verified these steps, your mileage may vary.

Current Malladus 2.0 Users!!!

If you are on Malladus 2.0 already, just do steps 2b, 4, 5, and 6. You're already good!

Directions:

1. make sure you are on the latest version of your recovery!!!
2.
 - a) if coming from a 4.2.2 rom, wipe system/data/cache
 - b) if coming from stock 24a, you can flash clean (wipe data/cache) or dirty(cache)
 - c) if coming from aosp 4.4.2, follow 2a
3.
 - a) if coming from an 10b or 11a, flash vs980_1xx_to_24a_twrp.zip to prep for 4.4.x
 - b) if coming from an 12b, flash vs980_1xx_to_24a.zip to prep for 4.4.x
 - c) if coming from 24a stock WITHOUT custom recovery, install a recovery and then do 3a
 - d) if coming from aosp 4.4.x, follow 3a
 - e) if coming from 24a stock WITH custom recovery, skip this step
 - f) if coming from Malladus 2.0, skip this step
4. flash malladus-vs980-2.0.2.zip
5. flash lg_apps_kk-20140412.zip (optional, if you want the extra lg apps)
6. flash gapps-kk_l-20140707.zip
7. wipe cache/dalvik if you didn't do step 2
8. reboot and enjoy!

Notes:

There have been ZERO hard bricks from this process. There were two soft bricks (one on a very early beta and one from a user on 10b). If you get lost along the way and need help, DON'T DO ANYTHING CRAZY AND ASK ME.... I'M HERE TO HELP!

For the most part, that's just general warning. You should be fine, seriously. The hard part has been done and I thank the testers for their time.

FAQs:

Q1. How can I restore to 11a or 12b stock?

A1. Follow this guide

Q2. Does Mobile Hotspot report anything to Verizon?

A2. No, it has been hacked. Nothing gets reported to Verizon.

Q3. Are there any bugs?

A3. None that I know of.

Q4. Is this ROM debloated?

A4. Yes!

Q5. I lost root! How can I get it back?

A5. Just flash the latest SuperSU zip in recovery

Q6. I lost recovery! How can I get it back?

A6. Download Flashify from the Play Store and flash the following recovery image

Q7. I get a Security Error on the LG boot screen! Help!

A7. This error means you messed up a step. If you did a backup, just restore it. If you don't have a backup, try flashing the ROM again and follow the steps carefully. If you don't have Recovery, boot into Download Mode and TOT back to stock and start over.

Q8. Does SetCPU or any similar cpu tweaking apps work with the included kernel?

A8. Not at the moment, but more kernels will likely pop up soon.

Q9. Where can I get Windows drivers for the VS980 LG G2?

A9. Right here

Q10. I'm on AOSP but my baseband says 12B, why do I need to act like I'm coming from 11A?

A10. Because you never know what the custom ROM may have changed or if it's based on a full stock or just partial. It's safer to assume you need everything upgraded to avoid issues.

Q11. Can I go back to a 4.2.2 ROM after upgrading to a 4.4.2 ROM with this process?

A11. Yes, but be sure to flash a 12B Radio at the same time you flash your 4.2.2. ROM!
